MURALHAS COM HISTÓRIA 2023 EXHIBITION AREAS

In the most beautiful Sortelha, we go back to the experiences of the reign of D. Afonso III, who ascended the throne in unforeseen circumstances since Pope Innocent IV, given the state of anarchy in which the country was, removed the government of D. Sancho II, his brother, and appoints the Count of Bologna, governor, and defender of the kingdom. As D. Sancho II refused to respect the papal decision, there was a dispute for the throne between the two brothers, and Portugal entered a period of civil war. In this dispute between the two brothers, Sortelha sided with D. Afonso III.

King Afonso III was crowned in 1248, after the king's death. The beginning of his reign was occupied in asserting his power and establishing order in the kingdom. He invested in the conquest of the Algarve and expelled the Moors from the territory, and the dominion over this territory was recognized with the signing of the Treaty of Badajoz, with his cousin, Afonso X of Castile, in 1267. From 1268, his royal title was recognized as Godly conceded, D. Afonso III, King of Portugal, and the Algarve.

D. Afonso III was an excellent administrator, organized public administration, founded several villages, and granted the privilege of a city through the edict of several charter letters.

As the king promulgated measures that led to the centralization of power, there were several conflicts between the clergy and the crown. Some prelates leave for Rome, complaining of abuses of power. The king received support from the courts of Santarém in January 1274, where a commission, who later acquitted him, was appointed to investigate the accusations made to him by the bishops. Pope Gregory X, however, did not accept the resolution and ordered the king to be excommunicated and banned from the kingdom in 1277. On his death in 1279, D. Afonso III swore obedience to the Church and the restitution of everything he had taken from her, reconciling himself with the Holy Church and committing himself to fulfil all the demands.

His eldest son, D. Dinis, succeeded him, and would permanently mark this borderland territory.

Sortelha is the ideal setting to travel back in time... there is no other place you will feel carried back to the Middle Ages as much as in our 'Muralhas com História'.

♦ Military Camp

Composed of displays of weapons, helmets, shields, medieval-style cooking, and medieval tents. Here, combat techniques are trained, military tactics are defined, and training is carried out, as the alert is permanent.

♦ Tournament Field

Space for recreation of medieval tournaments on horseback and foot, as well as demonstrations with birds of prey.

♦ Camping with Medieval Experiences

It consisted of a campaign kitchen, armoury and production of chain mail, scriptorium of calligraphy, weaving, braiding and embroidery, giving an insight into the people's way of life back then.

♦ Medieval Crafts

In Rua dos Ofícios, some of the arts and crafts that existed in the Middle Ages are recreated, such as blacksmithing, woodworking, net-making, and leather tanning.

♦ Falconry

Falconry is the art of raising, training, and caring for falcons and other birds of prey for hunting. Some documents on falconry show that it was an aristocratic sport, in which kings and other powerful members of the courts participated.

♦ Medieval Games

Space where adults and petitions can experience children's games inspired by medieval culture and the medieval carousel.

♦ Farm Animals

Exhibition of farm animals that once roamed freely in the streets of the old village.
